2022-2023 Canandaigua USBC No Tap Rules and Information

1. Eligibility: Bowlers will be required to show their USBC certification card. Non-members may participate by filling out certification card and paying the \$9 local only membership fee.
2. Handicap-Average: Averages will be based on 2021-2022 bowling season unless current average is ten pins higher which then the participant will use this year's average to determine their handicap. Bowlers without an official 21 game average from last season or this season may bowl scratch. Sport averages will be adjusted according to the USBC Average Conversion Chart. Anyone recording an incorrect average will be automatically disqualified per USBC rule 319a, item 3. USBC Youth averages will not be accepted.
3. Entries will be accepted until the last squad. The Canandaigua USBC reserves the right to hold squads at any time until the last squad of the tournament.
4. Rules: All USBC Rules not included here will be in effect. The Tournament Director will resolve all disputes, subject to rule 329.
5. We will be using a 1:8 payout ratio for the prize list.
6. Each bowler may only cash once in this event. A split of the 300 pot can only be earned once per series.
7. Entry Fee Distribution: Entry fees for this tournament are distributed as follows: Bowling Expense \$13.50, Tournament Expense \$3.00, Prize fund \$13.50, Total \$30.00.
8. Check-In Procedures: All entrants are to report for check-in 30 minutes prior to squad time. The tournament director has the discretion to close all entries 15 minutes prior to start of squad time.
9. Refunds: No entry fees will be refunded. All returned checks will be assessed a \$30.00 fee.
